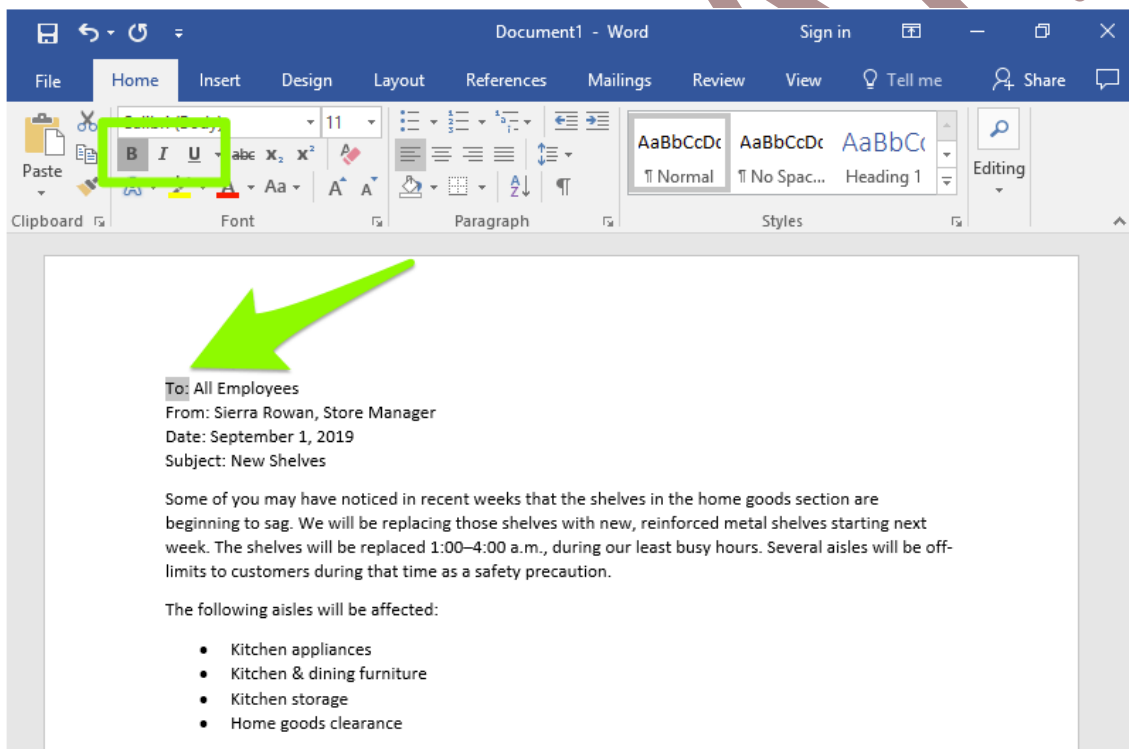
What Is Microsoft Word?

You may be wondering: *what type of program is Microsoft Word?* A good definition is that it's a word processor. That's an application you use to “process”—format, manipulate, save, print, share — a text-based document.

Bold, Italics, Underline

When formatting a document, you may need to emphasize or distinguish words. You can do this with **bold**, *italics*, underline, or all three.

To bold, italicize, or underline, select the text you want to change. Then, select the Bold, Italics, or Underline button in the Home tab as shown below.

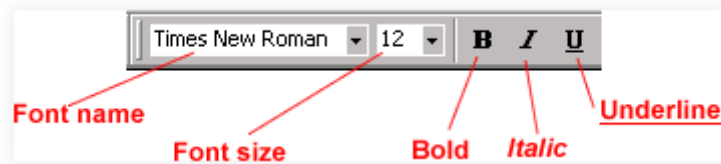


You can also select the text, then use a shortcut:

Bold	Ctrl+B (Command+B for Macs)
<i>Italics</i>	Ctrl+I (Command+I for Macs)
Underline	Ctrl+U (Command+U for Macs)

Using the Bold, Italics, and Underline features

To give you more options, Word lets you display text as **bold**, *italicized*, or underlined, regardless of the font and font size you choose.
